



PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

The public is invited to a meeting to overview the goals of a Benton and Baintertown Dam Engineering Feasibility Study and discuss anticipated field investigation activities. The meeting will be held on Tuesday April 27th, 2021 at 6:00PM EST at Sunnyside Park, Clinton Street, New Paris, Indiana (south of CR 46).

The Elkhart County Parks & Recreation Department has received an Indiana Department of Natural Resources Lake and River Enhancement (LARE) grant to determine the feasibility of modifying or removing two low head dams located within the River Preserve County Park. The two dams are known as the Benton and Baintertown Dams and they no longer serve their original purpose. This study will determine the feasibility of modifying or removing one or both dams from the Elkhart River to improve biological diversity and safety in the watershed.

The purposes of the Engineering Feasibility Study are to:

- 1. Determine feasibility of anticipated dam modifications or removals.
- 2. Prepare for physical removal or modification of the dams.
- 3. Ensure project success by addressing any issues that affect dam modification or removal, including gathering landowner and community input.
